HMI VISIT POST OFSTED...

As part of the process of 'getting to good' following Ofsted, a 1 day inspection occurs by a HMI officer to assess whether the school is taking effective action in relation to Ofsted's findings during their inspection.

This important visit took place on Friday 3rd July (7 weeks after the Ofsted inspection). The HMI officer visited all classes and observed teaching; looked at pupil's work; talked to pupils and interviewed the senior Leadership team, the Local Authority and the Vice Chair of Governors. After a gruelling day we are very pleased to announce that the judgement we received is that we are and have been taking EFFECTIVE ACTION to meet the Ofsted recommendations and drive school improvement.

UNIFORM : ARE YOU READY FOR SEPTEMBER???



Our uniform changes come into affect from September, and will be monitored within our Assertive Mentoring approach (traffic light system)

The uniform will remain exactly the same except:

- polo shirts will be pale blue.
- Year 6 will wear shirts in pale blue rather than polo shirts and will wear a school tie in pale blue and burgundy
- Burgundy V neck and crew neck sweatshirts are also available to be ordered for Y6, or any other pupil, should you wish to do so.
- Black SHOES must be worn by all pupils. If your child comes to school in anything other than black shoes they will be required to wear a pair of school plimsolls , until they have the required footwear.
- All children must have a PE kit consisting of black shorts; a T shirt in their team colour and black plimsolls (please speak to your child's class teacher if you are unsure of the team)

Can I strongly advise all parents to name all their child's uniform, including PE kit, pump bag, school bag, school coat, shoes and pumps and lunch boxes. If all items were clearly labelled it would make finding lost items so much easier. Thank you for your co operation.
