## SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

### SCHOOL UNIFORM: Reception to Year 6 pupils

We are proud of our school uniform and encourage pupils to take a pride in their dress and appearance. The required uniform is as follows:

Sweatshirts, cardigans and polo shirts embroidered by with the school logo can be ordered and bought from the school office, as can a range of other school uniform items that contain the school logo e.g. school coats, fleeces, book bags, pump bags and caps to name the most popular items.

PE T-shirts, in the house colours, and PE shorts can also be bought through the school office.

## **UNIFORM CHANGES FROM SEPTEMBER 2015**

Please note that from September 2015 uniform will remain broadly the same except for the following changes:

- **YEARS RECEPTION TO YEAR 5:** the polo shirt will be PALE BLUE rather than white.
- **YEAR 6:** pupils will be expected to wear PALE BLUE long or short sleeved shirts and a school tie.

Polo shirts, school shirts and ties will all be able to be ordered and purchased from the school office.

No child is allowed to undertake any P.E. activities while wearing earrings, watches or jewellery of any kind. Children should either remove such jewellery themselves or come to school with plasters over their studs. All jewellery must be removed for swimming.			

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM: Nursery Children**

There is no uniform stipulated for Nursery children. However if parents wish their child to wear Mosscroft's uniform then that is totally permissible, alternatively school track suits ( sweat shirts and jogging bottoms) can be purchased from the school office, which are popular with many of the Nursery parents. As a general consideration Nursery children should wear clothes that they are comfortable in and which allow them to explore and play within the Nursery setting and clothes that they will not worry about getting messy should that occur!

### **NURSERY AND RECEPTION CHILDREN: additional requests**

As outdoor provision is a daily option for the children within the Nursery and Reception classes, the Foundation stage Team also encourage parents to provide a pair of wellington boots, that can stay in school, for the children to be able to wear to play outside in on wet days.
